I would like to invite you to explore the New Jersey Technology Fellowship Program with Evex.

The New Jersey Commission on Science and Technology's mission is to encourage economic development and job growth in New Jersey; NJCST is placing New Jersey post-doctoral graduates in New Jersey technology companies. NJCST offers fellowships of \$50,000 for up to two years to post doctoral graduates who are hired by New Jersey technology companies.

- prepared to receive a degree within six months or have just received a degree within the past six months from a New Jersey university. (Occasional exceptions may be made for someone who has received their degree within the last 2 years).
- Postdoc must be in good standing with the conferring university
- Postdoc must continue to live in New Jersey while holding this fellowship
- Postdoc must be: 1) US Citizen; or 2) Legal Permanent Resident; or 3) Individuals with a valid immigrant visa, a valid Employment Authorization Document, and an I-485 application pending with the United States Citizenship and Immigration Service.

Evex's interest includes but is not limited to the following postdoc with the following credentials.

- Electrical Engineering – for electronic circuit system design
- Chemical Engineering / Material Science - for new sensors development
- Business Administration – for business development

Spring Application Phase Due: 5 p.m. Monday March 27, 2006. Spring Awards will be announced in April 2006. Decisions will be made based on the value of the proposed placement to the New Jersey economy.
